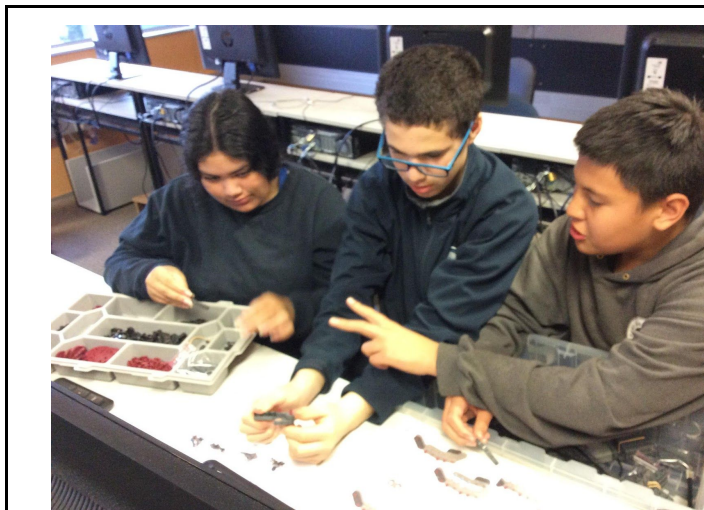
The last week of term three! The year rushes on!
